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closed, a depth which the color goes beyond its opaqueness. The precision is not really a matter of geometry it is a matter of light; of balance between different intensities of light, which create an inner motion in where the areas seem to be precisely defined. This is not a question of hard edges, it is a question of complementing intensities of values, which try to create an overall mystical experience. They move and they are contemplative. They seem to be paintings 'unveiled' as if reality was 'there' that has been made sensible. There is within the painting a reverberation on area of color pushing or pulling another color area continuously, it makes the painting alive. Many painters have done paintings in which areas of color vibrate with other areas, but they seem to miss a dimension of spirituality that is reached here.
